## FY 2011 Budget Update

The Fairfax County School Board has voted to adopt the Fairfax County Public Schools Fiscal Year 2011 advertised budget of \$2.3 billion, restoring some programs previously identified for elimination in the proposed budget. Restoration of these programs depends on whether or not FCPS receives adequate funding from the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors and the state.

The purpose of the meeting is to show how to be part of the process of developing the budget, it is not to advocate for specific programs.
